In the United States, someone has a heart attack every 34 seconds. Approximately 300,000 people in the United States experience an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest each year. Approximately 4 out of 5 sudden cardiac arrests happen at home.

When the heart stops beating, a victim's chance of survival decreases by 7-10% for every minute that defibrillation is delayed.

About half of Americans (49%) have one of three key risk factors that increase their chances for heart disease or having a heart attack: high blood pressure, high LDL cholesterol, and smoking. Other medical conditions and lifestyle choices that can put people at risk include diabetes, obesity, and excessive alcohol use.

Few victims experiencing sudden cardiac arrest outside of a hospital survive unless a rapid sequence of events takes place in the first few minutes: Recognition and Action, CPR, Defibrillation, Advanced Care.
